Durant Community School Education Foundation Scholarship - Form

This scholarship is to recognize a well-rounded student who shows good moral judgment, community involvement, and academic achievement.

Any graduating high school member of the Durant Community School will be eligible for this scholarship.

The scholarship recipient will be determined by a committee consisting of members of the Foundation and the Durant community. The committee will be led by the vice-president of the Durant Education Foundation. The scholarship will be a one time scholarship for \$500.00. It will be paid to the scholarship recipient at the beginning of the second semester of college schooling, after verification of enrollment has been shown to the Foundation.

The money for this scholarship will come from the interest earned from the Durant Community School Foundation in the Community Foundation from the Great River Bend fund.

The organization of the scholarship committee is as follows:

- A. The head of the scholarship committee will be the vice-president of the Durant Education Foundation.
- B. The committee will consist of the vice-president, one other member of the Foundation, and three community members chosen by the vice-president.
- C. Three new community members will be picked each year for the scholarship process.

To be eligible, students will fill out an application and participate in an interview with the committee. It is the responsibility of the vice-president to make applications available to students (through the guidance office's website).

The completed application needs to be returned to the Foundation (Superintendent's office) by April 22nd. Interviews will be set up later.
