Durant American Legion Post 430 Scholarship for Graduating Durant High School Students

The Durant American Legion Post 430 annually presents a Citizenship Award to two senior students whom we believe best exemplify the qualities of citizenship recognized by the American Legion. This award is in the form of financial aid to the school in the amount of \$300.00 for each winner.

The students must write and submit an essay, consisting of not more than 500 words, stating his/her *citizenship qualities* and *accomplishments*. Judges will also be looking for fine ideals in Americanism, loyalty to country and the ability to accept a citizen's responsibilities in the future.

Additional information about the students educational goals, extra-curricular activities, civic activities and any awards received may be submitted as supporting documentation. This will be in addition to the citizenship essay.

The Post Chairman must receive all applications by May 1. Winners will be notified at the Durant High School graduation. Winners will be expected to attend a Post 430 meeting to receive their scholarship and inform the members of the school they will be attending.
