NOVEMBER 22, 2021  
Unofficial Minutes

The work session started at 5:45 pm following the special meeting.

Mr. Burnett reviewed the proposed FY23 school calendar. The calendar public hearing will be held on December 13, 2021 at 5:30 pm.

Mr. Burnett spoke to the board about offering an FY22 retirement incentive for the 17 staff members that would qualify this year. The incentive will be on the December regular meeting agenda for approval.

Every November the district receives an additional SAVE payment for the prior fiscal year which is deposited into the Capital Project account. This year the district received an additional payment of \$80,052.46.

Ms. Stineman reviewed the changes to the Return to Learn Plan for Winter 2021/2022. The plan will be revisited through 2024 as the current funding for Covid expires at that time. The Return to Learn Plan was scaled back as the Covid-19 positivity rates have decreased. The hope is that the district will continue to pair down the plan going forward and to return to a normal school setting.

Mr. Burnett made the board aware that the OSHA mandate for vaccination and weekly testing of employees had been put on hold as a federal judge has ordered a stay on the mandate.

According to Mr. Burnett, the most recent Facility Advisory Meeting with OPN Architects went well and a survey was given to the members of the committee. The next meeting will include discussion about the survey results and formulating a list of needs of the district.

The next regular board meeting will be immediately following the Calendar Public Hearing on December 13, 2021 at 5:30 pm.

The work session adjourned at 6:15 pm.
