Unofficial Minutes

Mr. Burnett began the work session at 5:35 pm. Board members present include Julie Rivera, Travis Bullard, Carla Whitlock, Tara Lindsay and Katy Oberlander.

Tom Wuestenberg, Maintenance Director, met with an architect on February 18<sup>th</sup> and it was determined that the project would entail more than simply replacing the windows due to the original design of the windows and walls. There is a weather-related problem with the track and Mr. Wuestenberg will contact the contractor to determine the best way to make the repair. The house located at 310 7<sup>th</sup> Street will be torn down in March and High Traffic Flooring will be here over spring break to work on the High School commons and the Memorial Hallway epoxy flooring project. Mr. Wuestenberg will have Advanced Environmental in to check for asbestos before HTF starts the flooring project.

Also discussed was burying power lines in the elementary alley, additional parking, student drop off points and potential locations for the elementary offices.

Mr. Burnett reminded the board that the next meeting with OPN Architects is next Tuesday, March 8<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Stineman provided a handout that includes information on committees (Attendance, PBIS and BLT), enrollment updates and upcoming events in the elementary school. Ms. Stineman reviewed the Continuous Improvement Process and the 2019, 2020 and 2022 BLT learning process with the results of their efforts in the areas of Leadership, Assessment & Data-Based Decision Making, Universal Instruction, Intervention System and Infrastructure.

Mr. Diederichs shared upcoming events in the High School including ACT testing next Tuesday, Parent Teacher Conferences next week, the NHS Banquet, ISASP Testing, Bi-Literacy testing, Prom and Graduation.
